Tending the Flame (of Witnessing)

My Dear Friends in Christ... We just celebrated Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came to the church with tongues of fire over the disciples heads, and allowed the disciples to tell "the mighty works of God" to people in their own languages (Acts 2: 11).

On the Day of Pentecost, the languages the Holy Spirit used were actual linguistic tongues that the disciples didn't understand, but the hearers did! The Holy Spirit still uses the church today to "speak" to people about the mighty works of God in ways that we may not fully understand, but the hearers do! It may be lending a helping hand to a person in need, offering a word of encouragement to someone when life has them down, or just being present with someone as they grieve. The Holy Spirit uses these times to touch people with the love of God in Christ. These times offer us an opportunity to witness to others of our faith in Christ. But do we always take advantage of those times? ... If not, why not? ... Maybe it's because we're not sure how to go about it.

This summer, our District is offering a great opportunity to learn how to witness from some of the best in our Synod. It's the August 2-4, 2013 Tending The Flame Conference in Richmond, Va. This year's Conference is one of eight Regional Outreach Conferences (ROCs) being put on by Lutheran Hour Ministries. The speakers will include Rev. Greg Seltz, the current Lutheran Hour Speaker; Rev. Mark Zehnder, pastor of King of Kings in Omaha, Nebraska; Rev. John Denninger, president of our Southeastern District, LCMS; Rev. Bill Harmon; pastor of King of Glory in Williamsburg, Va.; and many speakers from the Lutheran Hour Ministries Mission University. Mike Merker, pastor of Jordan Lutheran in Apex, will serve as the Conference Chaplain, and Kip Fox (singer/songwriter/guitarist) will serve as worship leader.

Workshops include such titles as: "Sharing the Hope of Jesus with Muslims"; "Rock Your Witness" (presenting the Gospel to those with different world-views); "Sharing the Gospel in a Digital Age"; "Serving the Mission Field on my Street"; "Just an Everyday Witness"; "Manly Tools for Faith Sharing"; and "Outreach to E-Groups".

Beth and I plan to attend this Conference and we invite as many of you as can to join us. There are programs for Teens and children (K-7) as well. You can find more details on our District's web site (www.se.lcms.org) or on Lutheran Hour Ministries' Website (www.lhm.org/roc). The cut-off date for registering for the Conference is Tuesday July 30, 2013. In order to be guaranteed the \$93/night room rate at the Koger Center, register with the hotel by July 10, 2013.

Make plans to attend and "TEND THE FLAME" (of witnessing) so that the Holy Spirit can use you when the opportunity arises.

Stewardship/Finance

Thank you to all who have continued to faithfully support the work of God at Advent Lutheran Church. Advent appreciates the donations of all of you as you give out of gratitude and love for what God has done for us through Jesus, our Savior. Listed below are the income and expense figures from January 1, 2013 through May 20, 2013. The income includes the weekly plate offering, Thrivent Choice donations, building rental income, and mission donations. Any donations that are designated for a specific purpose are not included.

Income received through 5/20/2013 \$ 60,849.16 Expenses through 5/20/2013 \$ 60,732.60 Income vs. Expense \$ 116.56

While these figures look okay on the surface, we need to look a little deeper into the facts. In order to meet the 2013 projected expenses that were proposed by council and approved by voters at our January 2013 voters' meeting, Advent requires an average monthly income of \$12,692.00. Through May 20, income and expenses are almost equal, but income is on target only because one family has already given its total yearly donation. Expenses, on the other hand, are lower than projected. Some of our larger expenses (like insurance) have yet to be billed. If we were to prorate both the known fixed expenses and the annual donation already received over the entire year, Advent's financials would show a deficit of over \$5000.

Historically, Advent's weekly offerings are highest during the 1st quarter of the year. During the summer months, attendance and offerings fluctuate. We have eight members who make certain their offering is consistent year-round by donating electronically through a program offered by the Lutheran Church Extension Fund. You do not have to have an account with LCEF to participate and there are no fees. Your donation is transferred from your bank account to Advent's account either once a month or weekly (your choice). Church Council Report


