Your soft merciful love. As the surgeons begin their work, bless their efforts and bring healing to Pastor Scott's body. Please continue to protect him and keep him in Your care. May he and his family feel Your presence during his recovery. Amen.

7. Almighty God, our heavenly Father. Graciously comfort Your servant Scott and bless the means made for him to be restored to good health. Fill his heart with confidence and thanksgiving through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

8. Lord Jesus, help Pastor Scott as he prepares for his surgery today. In Your love, guard and protect him through the skills of the medical team and the care of everyone else. Bring him back to health and full recovery. Lord Jesus, we praise You forever and ever. Amen.

9. Lord, Your Word speaks promises of healing and restoration and we thank You for the miracles You still perform today. Today we claim those promises for our pastor. We believe in the healing power of faith and prayer and we ask You to begin Your might work in the life of Pastor Scott. Please reach down and surround him and his family with supernatural peace and strength and give them the faith to believe that all things are possible for You. Amen.

10. O merciful Father in heaven, thank You for being with Pastor Scott while he was in surgery. Thank You for blessing the surgeons and other medical professionals with the skill and knowledge needed to do their work and for safely bringing Pastor Scott through this operation. Help him to grow in strength each day and bring him to full recovery quickly, Amen.
